**BYLAW NO. 2511**

**A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE THE PAYMENT OF AN ANNUAL REMUNERATION TO EACH MEMBER OF COUNCIL.**

The Council of the District of Campbell River, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "**Council Remuneration Bylaw No. 2511, 1996**".
2. There shall be paid out of the annual revenue of the District of Campbell River, remuneration as follows:
  - (a)
    - (i) Commencing December 1st, 1996, the Mayor will be paid the sum of \$45,000 per annum;
    - (ii) Commencing January 1, 2001, each Councillor will be paid the sum of \$16,275.00 per annum;
    - (iii) Commencing December 1st, 1996, the Acting Mayor will be paid the sum of \$495.18 per month.
  - (b) For the calendar year 1998, and for each subsequent calendar year thereafter, the annual remuneration set out in subsection (a) shall be increased or decreased from the remuneration for the immediately preceding calendar year by a percentage amount equal to the percentage increase or decrease in the official Consumer Price Index for Canada (all items) published by Statistics Canada (1971 = 100) for the period January 1st to December 31st in the immediately preceding calendar year.
  - (c) Notwithstanding 2(b) the Councillor remuneration established by Bylaw No.2891, 2001 will not be subject to clause 2(b) until 2002.
3. One third of the remuneration paid shall be an allowance for expenses incidental to the discharge of the duties of office.

4.
  - i) The Mayor will be entitled to health care benefits with 100% of the premiums paid by the District of Campbell River.*
  - ii) Councillors will be entitled to health care benefits with 100% of the premiums paid by the individual.*
5. This Bylaw shall be reviewed every six years.

6. "Council Indemnity Bylaw No. 1125, 1981" is hereby repealed, but not so far as to revive any provisions not contained therein.
