A Public Hearing will be held in the Council Chambers of City Hall located at 301 St. Ann's Road in Campbell River, B.C. at 6:30 p.m. on June 6, 2017 to provide an opportunity for public input on Bylaw No. 3663, 2017.

What is the purpose of Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 3663, 2017?

To rezone 2200 Shetland Road from Residential Estate One (RE-1) to Rural Recreation (RR-1), and to update the "Golf Course" definition to include the modern golf course operation ancillary uses of "accommodations", "retail", and "health and wellness facilities".

Where can I view a copy of the bylaw?

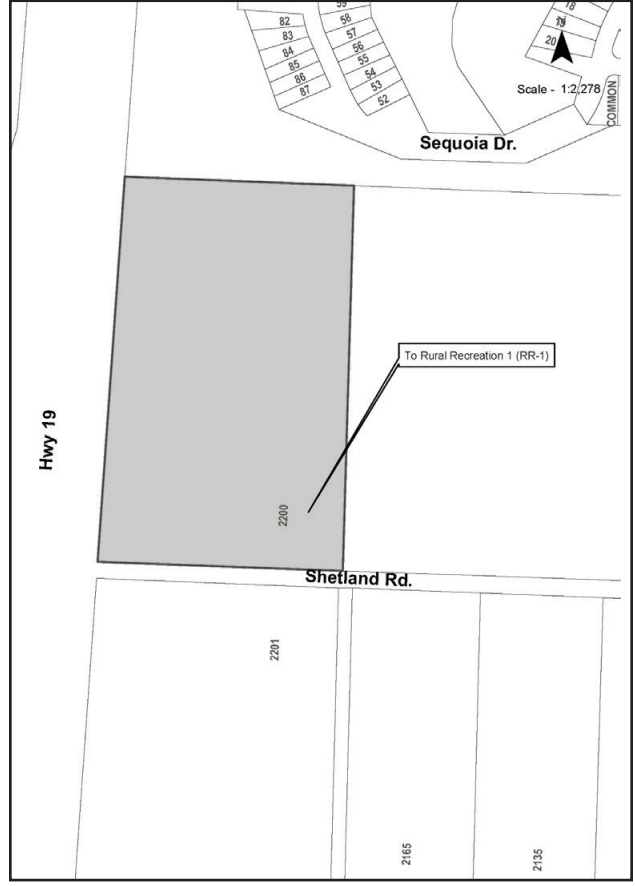
