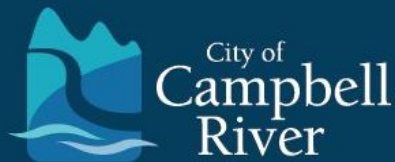


ALL COLLECTIONS

- Materials should be curbside by 7:30 am.
- Garbage, recycling and yard waste are collected by different trucks.
- Collection days are Monday to Friday including statutory holidays other than Dec. 25 and Jan. 1 (Collection scheduled for Dec. 25 and Jan. 1 occur the following collection day).
- To confirm the collection day for your area, please view the collection map at www.campbellriver.ca or contact **Emterra** at **250-286-0211**.
- Weight limit: 20kg (44lbs) for blue boxes, containers, bags and bundles.

GARBAGE WEEKLY COLLECTION

- The basic weekly service is one 80 litre can (maximum 20kg / 44lbs).
- Additional cans will be collected if a tag is attached. Single use tags can be purchased at City Hall, the Sportsplex or the Community Centre for \$2.50.
- Place garbage in a strong lidded, water tight container.
- No yard waste, recyclables, household furnishings, major appliances, construction materials, liquids or electronic products are permitted in household garbage.

RECYCLING WEEKLY COLLECTION

- Unlimited amounts accepted. Use City-supplied blue box or other open top container clearly marked *Recycling*. Individual containers should not exceed 68L or 20kg (44lbs).
- Flatten cardboard (36" X 36" maximum size) and place under the blue box.
- Place paper or boxboard at the bottom of the box with heavier plastic and metal containers on top.
- Contain shredded paper in boxes or paper bags.
- Recyclables may also be deposited at the multi-bin drop off sites (visit www.cswm.ca for locations).

Acceptable:

- Newspapers & flyers
- 100% paper products
- Clean pizza boxes
- Magazines
- Telephone books
- Flattened boxboard
- Aluminum food containers
- Plastic milk jugs
- Aluminum foil
- Tetra-Pak drink boxes
- Refundable beverage containers
- Plastic containers marked (1-7)



Not-acceptable:

- Plastic bags
- Plastics not marked with approved codes
- China & ceramics
- Electronics
- Light bulbs
- Aerosol cans
- Batteries
- Glass
- Styrofoam
- Wax paper
- Milk cartons
- Painted paper
- Gift wrap
- Oil containers

YARD WASTE SPRING & FALL COLLECTION (APRIL 1—MAY 24 & SEPTEMBER 30—NOVEMBER 22)

- Unlimited amounts accepted.
- Place yard waste in a rigid lidded container no larger than 80L each (maximum 20kg/44lbs), clearly marked **Yard Waste** in bold lettering.
- Biodegradable or compostable bags are accepted as long as each bag is labeled accordingly by the manufacturer.
- Tie branches and prunings in secure bundles measuring maximum 90cm (36") long and 60cm (24") wide. Individual branches must not exceed 7.5cm (3") in diameter.
- Tie bundles with twine or other biodegradable string.
- Residents can also visit the Yard Waste Drop-Off Centre for year round disposal of yard waste (west of the Inland Highway #19, off Willis Road.)

Acceptable:

- Plants and flowers
- Leaves
- Grass clippings
- Branches
- Tree or hedge trimmings
- Small amounts of sod or soil (not to exceed 20kg)

Not-acceptable:

- Animal feces
- Garbage
- Kitchen waste
- Home renovation or construction material
- Rocks or stumps
- Painted or treated wood
