FIRE BAN IN EFFECT

Campfires, backyard fires and beach fires are not permitted.

The fire ban also prohibits using items such as:

- fireworks
- sky lanterns
- torches
- burning barrels

The use of CSA-rated or ULC-rated campfire apparatus and cooking stoves that use liquid or gaseous fuel is allowed at this time, however, in extreme fire conditions, these may also be prohibited.
