- 1 Collect food waste in your green kitchen bin or container of your choice.
- 2 Empty the kitchen bin and yard waste into a **strong lidded** container made of plastic, rubber, or galvanized steel.
- 3 Place the strong lidded food and yard waste container at the curb on the day of collection.



HELP PREVENT CONTAMINATION

- ✘ NO plastic bags, plates or cutlery - even those labelled compostable or biodegradable.
- ✘ NO plastic or foam containers including takeout food containers.

PUBLIC NOTICE - PARCEL TAX REVIEW PANEL FOR WATER, SEWER, STORMWATER AND PARKS PARCEL TAX ASSESSMENT

NOTICE is hereby given that a Parcel Tax Review Panel for Water, Sewer, Storm Water and Parks Parcel Tax Assessment purposes will be held at 10 a.m. on Thursday, May 11, 2023 to hear complaints regarding the Water, Sewer, Storm Water and Parks Rolls for the year 2023.

You may make a complaint under *Section 205 of the Community Charter* to the Parcel Tax Review Panel for one or more of the following reasons:

- There is an error or omission about a name or address on the tax roll;
- There is an error or omission about the inclusion of a parcel;
- There is an error or omission about the taxable area or taxable frontage of a parcel;
- An exemption has been improperly allowed.

For a complaint to be heard by the Parcel Tax Review Panel, it must be received via email to Mark.Coulter@campbellriver.ca before 4 p.m. on May 8, 2023.

Be sure to state the address of the property in question and the reason for your appeal. **Notice given May 3, 2023.**
