A Public Hearing will be held in the Council Chambers of City Hall located at 301 St. Ann's Road in Campbell River, B.C. at 6:30 p.m. on September 6, 2016, to provide an opportunity for public input on Bylaw No. 3629, 2016.

Proposal for 1521 & 1581 Vanstone Road by Andrew Rippingale (City File ZON-00002):

To amend Zoning Bylaw 3250, 2006, to rezone the properties located at 1521 and 1581 Vanstone Road from Residential Multiple One (RM-1) to Residential One (R1) to allow single family residential dwellings or bed and breakfast accommodations to be constructed.

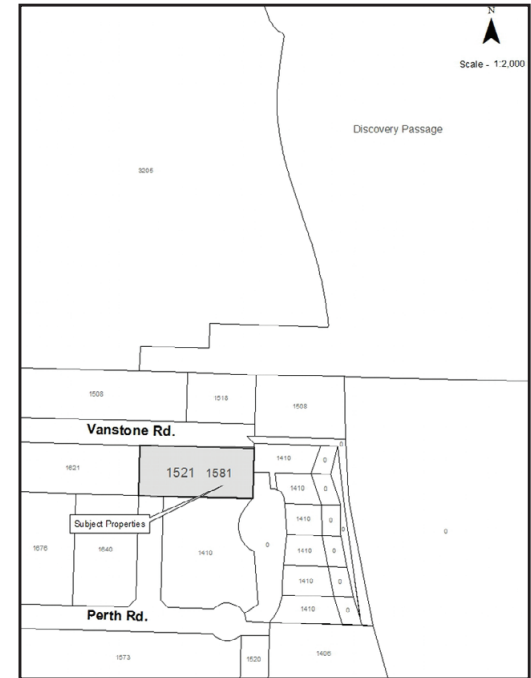

How can I provide comments?

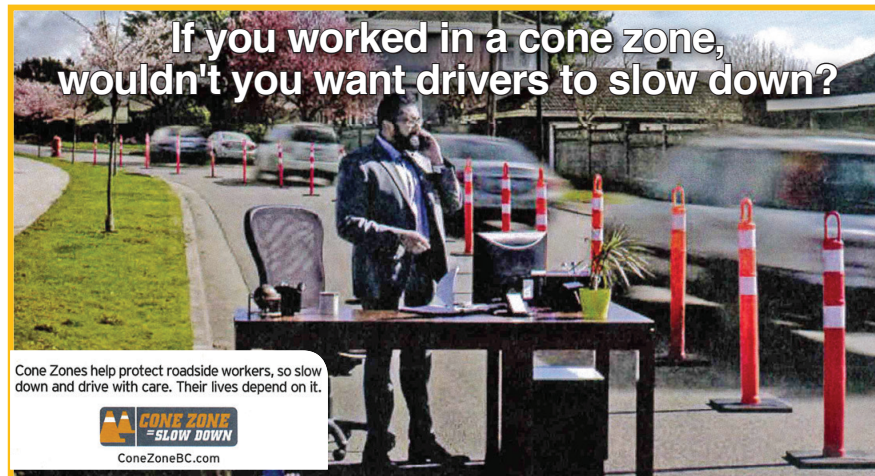
