

KEEP KIDS SAFE BACK TO SCHOOL TIPS FOR EVERYONE

With children heading back to school, the City, the school district and RCMP are asking drivers, cyclists and parents to watch out for kids along roadways.

Safety tips for sharing the road with children cycling:

- When passing someone riding a bicycle, proceed in the same direction slowly, and leave at least one metre between your car and the cyclist.
- When turning left and a cyclist is approaching in the opposite direction, wait for the rider to pass.
- If you're turning right, shoulder check for cyclists and let the rider go through the intersection first.
- Be prepared in case children on bicycles turn in front of you without looking or signaling
- Be extra vigilant in school zones and residential neighbourhoods.
- Watch for bikes coming from driveways, alleys and parking lots or behind parked cars.
- Check your side mirrors before opening your door.
