TIME TO APPLY FOR 2018 COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP GRANTS-IN-AID


Campbell River City Council will be accepting applications for 2018 Community Partnership grants-in-aid until **4:30 p.m. Friday, September 15, 2017.**
