Mayor Andy Adams elected to Island Coastal Economic Trust board

Mayor Andy Adams was one of two of the municipal representatives elected to the board of the Island Coastal Economic Trust (ICET) at the North Island Sunshine Coast Regional Advisory Committee meeting on Feb. 6, 2015 in Courtenay.

ICET is guided by a board of directors and two regional advisory committees, which include more than 50 locally elected officials and MLAs and five appointees to set regional funding priorities.

"ICET funds community-driven economic development initiatives such as the soon-to-be-completed Rotary suspension bridge here in Campbell River," says Mayor Andy Adams. "I look forward to actively participating on the board funding decisions in support of local and regional projects."

The \$50 million Island Coastal Economic Trust (ICET) was created by the Government of BC in 2006 to support economic development initiatives on central and northern Vancouver Island and the Sunshine Coast. ICET funds community-driven economic development initiatives in targeted sectors, including: forestry, transportation, tourism, mining, small business, energy, agriculture and aquaculture and economic development.
