The new gravel drop-off zone and parking lot for Haig Brown House and Kingfisher Creek have now been completed! These news lots will provide a much safer access and parking area for members of the public visiting the site and Greenways Land Trust (GLT) volunteers who provide landscaping maintenance work onsite.

Please note: Effective July and August, between 10:00 am and 3:00 pm, parking in the new lot is restricted to 10 minutes only, to ensure adequate space for parents to deliver children to the Haig Brown House summer camps. Access is unrestricted for the remainder of the year.

The Greenways Land Trust is a registered charity and conservation organization that works to enhance recreational and ecological greenways for people and wildlife. Operating since 1996, GLT continues to support volunteers, initiate projects and foster partnerships that work towards our goals and mission.
