
Galerno Road between Vista Bay and Cottonwood

On Time and On Budget!

Project Overview

Work under this project included the rehabilitation of the Simms Creek culvert passing under Galerno Road. The condition of the culvert had been monitored annually as part of the City's bridge and culvert inspection program and the 2012 inspection found that the condition of the culvert had deteriorated to the point that it was no longer capable of carrying the applied loads. Accordingly, through an open process, the City secured the services of a local civil contractor and engineering firm to design-build the necessary remedial works.

Upland Excavating Ltd. was awarded the Design Build Contract with McElhanney Consulting Services providing detail design. Construction of the project was fast tracked in order to comply with regulatory requirements with the City providing overall management and administration of the project. All works were completed within 7 weeks and resulted in enhanced fish habitat.



Funding for the Project

The entire project was delivered for \$280,000 with approved funds from the City's Storm Water Parcel Tax Reserve.
