Project Overview

Work under this project included the installation of a new above ground Pressure Reducing Valve Station near the Rockland/Alder intersection required to improve overall system performance for the southern portion of City’s water distribution network.

Koers & Associates Engineering Ltd. based out of Parksville completed the detail design and the project was publicly tendered in the Summer of 2012 with the tender being awarded to Wacor Holdings Ltd., of Campbell River. Construction was complete in December of 2012. An interesting feature of the new kiosk is the inclusion of an artistic wrap which was developed with local artist “Pete the Pen” Davies, intended to describe the City’s water system including this new PRV Station.



Funding for the Project

The total cost of design and construction works associated with the Rockland Alder PRV Project was \$375,000 against the approved budget of \$390,000 and was fully funded through the City’s Water Capital and Water Surplus Reserve Funds.
