

Q & A: Larwood Erickson Sewer Upgrade

Construction work has resumed on the Larwood Erickson Sewer Upgrade Project.

The following Questions and Answers are intended to provide an overview of the project.

1. What is the project?

Work under this project includes the renewal and upgrade of sanitary sewer mains on Erickson, Harrogate and Larwood Roads. These upgrades are required to address existing conditions and growth related demands in the Jubilee Heights Subdivision.



2. Where is the project?

The work is taking place along roadways on Larwood from Highway 19A to Harrogate, south on Harrogate to Erickson and west on Erickson to Fairmile.

3. When is the construction work going to take place?

The work on Larwood Road is almost complete. Once finished, the new sewer installation will continue from Harrogate to Erickson roads and proceed west until it reaches the end of this project at Fairmile Road.

4. What is the cost of the project?

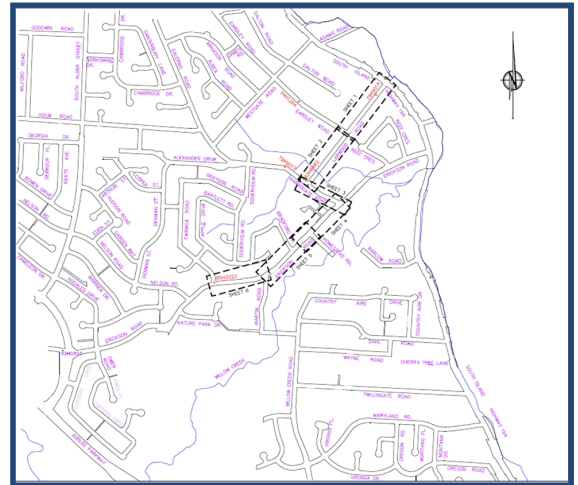
The project budget is \$3.9m with the project currently tracking on budget.

5. How is the project being funded?

The City and developer of Jubilee Heights have a cost sharing arrangement in place. The City's portion will be funded through the sewer capital reserve.

6. Who will be involved in the project design and construction?

The City engaged Highland Engineering Services Ltd. to complete detailed design. The tender for construction services was awarded to Windley Contracting Ltd.



7. How will traffic be managed during construction?

There will be disruption to traffic along the reflected route. Single lane alternating traffic should remain in place during the work; however, in the event that a road closure is required the alternate route will be posted on our website. Please obey all posted signage during the course of construction.
