

## ADVANCE CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

## → Your Sewer Access May Temporarily Be Affected! ←

Insituform Technologies<sup>®</sup> Limited (ITL) is under contract by the City of Campbell River to complete the rehabilitation of certain sanitary sewers in your area. As a result, both cleaning & repair work will be completed over the next few months. The Insituform® process repairs sewers without digging up the neighborhood. This helps to preserve your property and minimize any inconveniences.

Please be advised that during the construction, there may be some minor traffic disruptions, parking restrictions, and lane closures. In order to repair these old sewer systems, ITL will conduct the work in two stages. **Stage 1** involves cleaning the sewers using low pressure water jetting equipment to remove roots, grease, gravel and other debris. **Stage 2** is the CIPP (Cured In Place Pipe) lining process that uses a fiberglass resin. Please be advised that the use of the fiberglass resin odour could pose some inconvenience to the home and/or business owner, however these issues do not pose any health concerns.

While work is being performed in Stage 1, some homes may experience turbulence, smell, or noise in the septic pipes. If you have experienced related issues in the past such as bubbling toilets or spraying over, or if your residence is not equipped with a functioning backflow preventer, we strongly suggest keeping toilet lids closed and covered with a garbage bag and/or placing a heavy item on the lid to prevent any issues that may arise from the cleaning work.

Should the repair work directly affect you or your property for <u>Stage 2</u>, another notification will be left at your front door within 48-hours prior to conducting the actual lining work. This notification will provide you with information regarding the time and duration of the disruption as well as who to speak with should you have any concerns.
