The City of Campbell River is commencing with the 2021 Watermain Renewal Project—Hilchey Road Phase 2. The following questions and answers are intended to provide an overview of the projects.

1. What is the project?

3.

Work under these renewal projects consists of installing new watermains and domestic services throughout Campbell River. These new mains are to replace the sections of the water distribution system that have reached the end of there useful service life.

2. Where is the location of the work?

The location of the 2021 work is on Hilchey Road between Galerno Road and Hwy 19A, and on Galerno Road between Hilchey and Simms roads.

- What is the cost of the project? The estimated cost of the Hilchey Road Phase 2 construction is \$824,000.
- **4. How is the project being funded**? Budget was approved in the 2021 Capital Plan and is funded by the water reserve.
- 5. Who will be involved in the project?

The design work has been completed under a design-bid-build model by the City's Capital Works and Water Departments. Tender 21-06 for construction has recently closed and the submissions are under review.

- 6. When is the construction work going to take place? Construction will commence this Spring.
- 7. How will traffic be managed during construction? Traffic management during construction will be the responsibility of the contractor doing the work. There will be disruption with single lane alternating traffic through most of the project.
