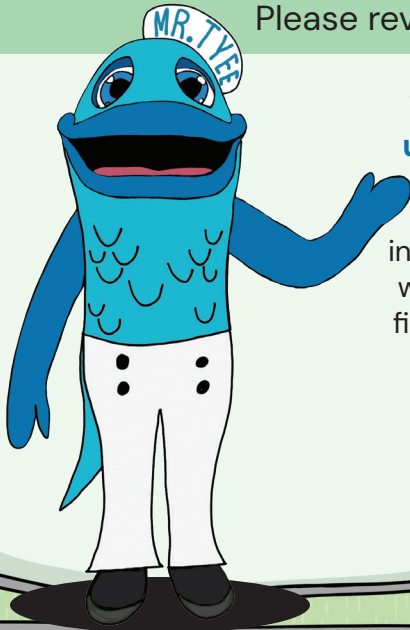

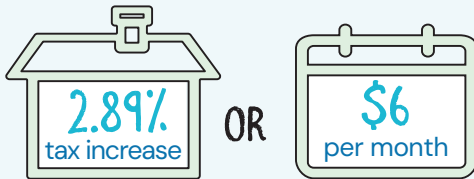

Average single-family home, valued at \$717,000

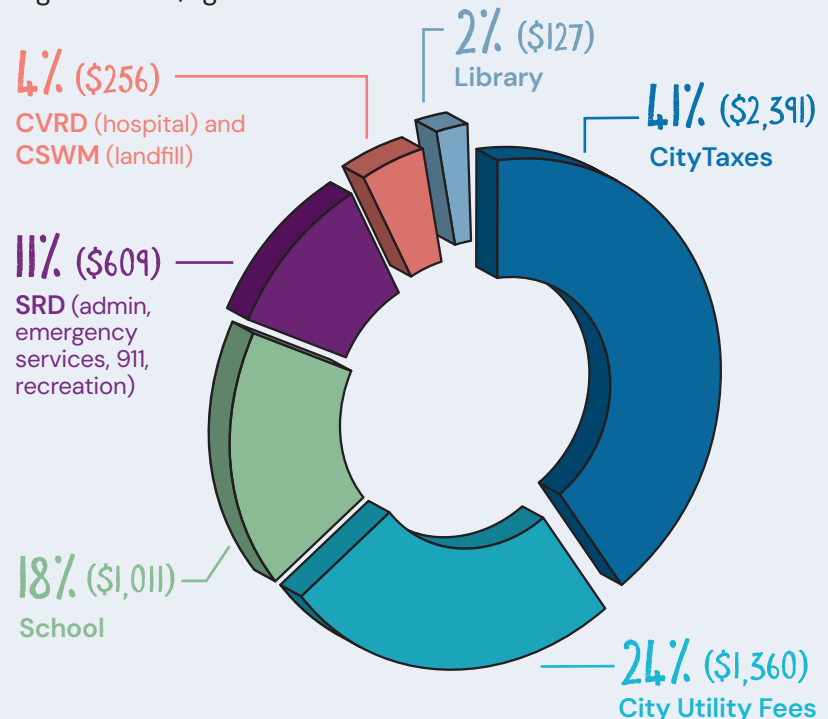

Budget highlights:

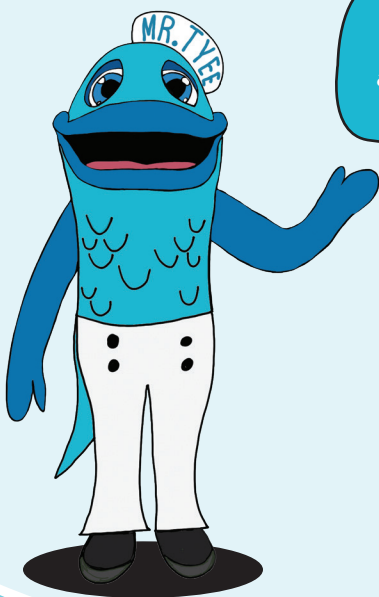
- ★ With 6.4% in additional costs for 2025, Council worked to increase revenue and create efficiencies to reduce the tax increase to 2.89% while ensuring reliable service delivery and sustainable investment in infrastructure and strategic priorities.
- ★ \$1.8 M invested in our downtown
- ★ \$69M in major capital projects
- ★ \$6.3 M in operating projects to maintain services
