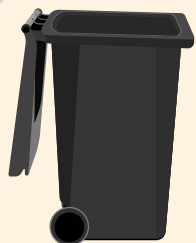


# GARBAGE, RECYCLING AND ORGANICS COLLECTION

Garbage, recycling and organics are collected weekly from single-family, duplexes, and some tri and four-plex homes in Campbell River. All materials should be placed curbside close to **7:30 a.m.** on your scheduled collection day.

## COLLECTION SCHEDULE

To find your collection schedule, download the CR Recycles App, visit [campbellriver.ca/solid-waste](http://campbellriver.ca/solid-waste) or contact Emterra at 250-286-0211. Register for email, text or telephone reminders about curbside collection schedules so you never miss a pick-up.



## GARBAGE


- Weekly pick-up is **80 litres (maximum 20 kg/44 lbs) per week per household.**
- Additional garbage will be collected if a garbage tag is attached. Single-use tags are available for purchase at City Hall, the Sportsplex or the Community Centre for **\$4.**
- Place garbage in a strong-lidded, water-tight container.
- Yard waste, recyclables, household furnishings, major appliances, construction materials, liquids or electronic products are not permitted in household garbage.



## RECYCLING

- Unlimited amounts of recycling are accepted. Place all recycling in a City supplied blue box or other open top container clearly marked *Recycling*. Individual containers should not exceed **68L or 20kg/44 lbs.**
- Flatten cardboard (**36" X 36" maximum size**) and place under the blue box.
- Place paper or boxboard at the bottom of the box with heavier plastic and metal containers on top.
- Contain shredded paper in boxes or paper bags.

- ✓ Aluminum foil, food containers
- ✓ Dairy, milk or egg substitute containers

- ✓ Plastic milk jugs

- ✓ Tetra-Pak drink boxes
- ✓ Refundable beverage containers
- ✓ Aerosol containers
- ✓ Plastic containers marked 1-7 

- ✗ Glass
- ✗ Styrofoam
- ✗ Wax paper
- ✗ Painted paper
- ✗ Gift wrap
- ✗ Oil containers
- ✗ Plastic bags

- ✗ Plastics not marked with approved codes
- ✗ China and ceramics
- ✗ Electronics
- ✗ Light bulbs
- ✗ Batteries

## ORGANICS

- Campbell River accepts food and yard waste year-round.
- A **360-litre limit**, per household, per week, is in place.
- Containers should weigh no more than **20kg/44 lbs** and should not exceed **121 litres** in size.



- ✓ Kitchen waste
- ✓ Leaves and grass
- ✓ Branches
- ✓ Plants and flowers
- ✓ Tree or hedge trimmings
- ✓ Small amounts of sod or soil (not to exceed 20kg)

- ✗ Rocks or stumps
- ✗ Painted or treated wood
- ✗ Animal feces
- ✗ Garbage
- ✗ Home renovation, construction materials
- ✗ Biodegradable bags and/or plastic bags

## Yard Waste

- Yard and garden trimmings, leaves, plants (living or dead/dried), flowers, sod, and small amounts of soil. Branches cut less than 7.5 cm (3 in) in diameter.
- Additional yard waste will be collected if a yard waste tag is attached. Single-use tags are available for purchase at City Hall, the Sportsplex or the Community Centre for **\$4.**
- **No plastic** compostable/ biodegradable bags, containers, or cutlery.

## Food Waste

- Provided green bins are for daily indoor food waste and are **NOT** to be used for curbside collection.
- Empty the food waste into a strong-lidded container made of plastic, rubber, or galvanized steel.
- Place the strong-lidded container at the curb on the day of collection.
