Centennial Pool is opening Tuesday, July 6.

“We’ve worked hard to get the pool prepped, painted and ready and are eager to welcome the community back to the pool after last year’s pandemic closure,” says pool supervisor, Dayna Stevenson.

New additions to the pool include a waterslide and a relaxation swim.

“A relaxation swim is a time for people to swim, water run, stretch or swim lengths in a calm and quiet atmosphere,” says head guard Amy Johnston.

Many favorite activities are back, including swim lessons, lengths, aquafit and fun swims. Fun swim themes will be posted weekly on the Recreation and Culture Facebook page.

Pool rentals and birthday party rentals will also be available this year.

- Access to toilets and outdoor showers will be available. You must still shower before swimming.
- Hand washing and/or sanitizing options are available.
- Stay home if you are showing any signs or symptoms of illness, have been travelling outside Canada, or have been in contact with a person displaying symptoms or has travelled outside Canada. (Health Check)
