BOUNDARY OF SAID LOT D

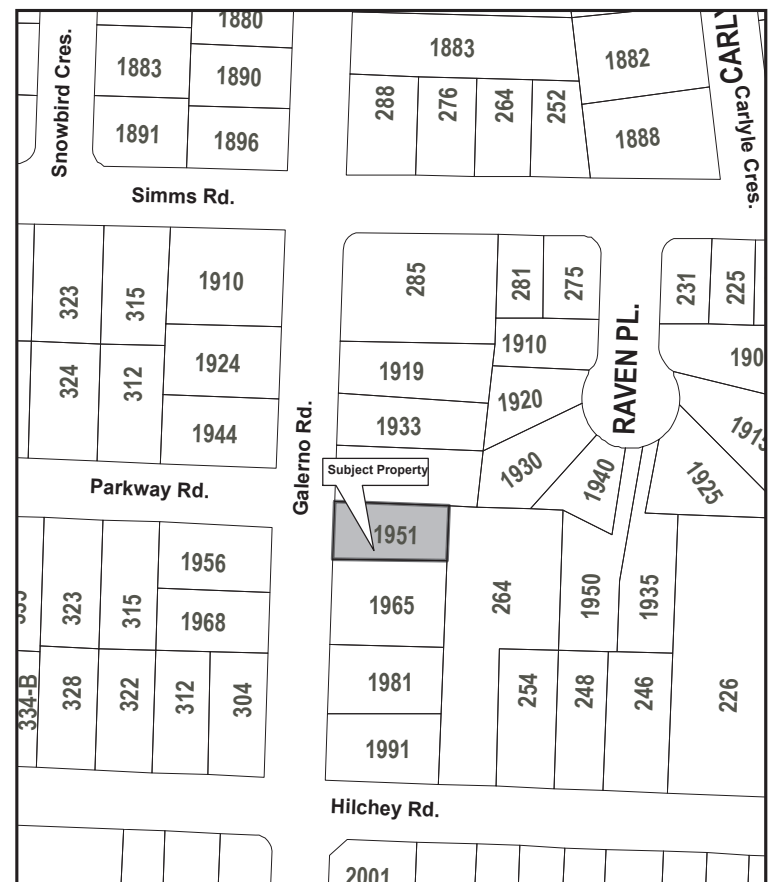
Where can I view a copy of the bylaw?
