
2018 Annual Report

2019 Community Beautification Grants Program in the Works

City Council is considering proposed 2019 beautification partnering agreements with the Campbellton Neighbourhood Association, Pier Street Association, Downtown Heart of the City Business Improvement Association and Willow Point Business Improvement Area Society. Under the agreements, these associations would receive up to \$10,000 each for improvements to public spaces in these commercial areas by adding features such as lighting, banners and flowers.

The City advertises the proposed partnering agreements as prescribed by Section 21 of the *Community Charter*, and Council will give final consideration to these agreements on June 24, 2019.

DOES YOUR ORGANIZATION CURRENTLY RECEIVE A PERMISSIVE PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION? IF YES,YOU WILL NEED TO REAPPLY THIS YEAR!!!

The City's current Permissive Tax Exemption (PTE) Bylaws expire in 2019 so all PTE recipients will need to reapply to be considered for an exemption in 2020 and beyond.

PTE applications, along with all supporting documentation, will be accepted until **4:30 p.m. Friday, June 21, 2019** for 2020 exemptions.

Permissive property tax exemptions are available for property that is either owned or held by a church, charitable, philanthropic or non-profit organization that meets the requirements prescribed by Section 224 of the Community Charter and City Council's Finance Policy.
