## DOES YOUR ORGANIZATION CURRENTLY RECEIVE A PERMISSIVE PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION? IF YES, YOU WILL NEED TO REAPPLY THIS YEAR!!!

*The City's current Permissive Tax Exemption (PTE) Bylaws expire in 2019 so all PTE recipients will need to reapply to be considered for an exemption in 2020 and beyond.*

PTE applications, along with all supporting documentation, will be accepted until **4:30 p.m. Friday, June 21, 2019** for 2020 exemptions.

Permissive property tax exemptions are available for property that is either owned or held by a church, charitable, philanthropic or non-profit organization that meets the requirements prescribed by Section 224 of the Community Charter and City Council's Finance Policy.
