PUBLIC HEARING WAIVED OPPORTUNITY FOR INPUT Zoning Bylaw Amendment 3772, 2020

File: P2000015
Addresses: 325, 329 and 335 Erickson Road

As Public Hearings will be cancelled for the foreseeable future, please consider this notice that the Public Hearing requirement for the above noted bylaw has been waived and will proceed to Third Reading on May 25, 2020. The City is permitted to waive Public Hearings pursuant to the following criteria outlined in *Section 464* of the *Local Government Act*:

- (2) A local government may waive the holding of a public hearing on a proposed zoning bylaw if
- (a) an official community plan is in effect for the area that is subject to the zoning bylaw, and
- (b) the bylaw is consistent with the official community plan.

Those that wish to provide comments for Council's consideration in regards to Bylaw No. 3772, 2020 will still have the opportunity to do so prior to Third Reading.

What is the purpose of Zoning Amendment Bylaw 3772, 2020?

The purpose of Bylaw No. 3772, 2020 is to rezone the properties at 325, 329 and 335 Erickson Road from Residential One (R-1) Zone to Residential One A (R-1A) Zone to permit one secondary suite on each property.

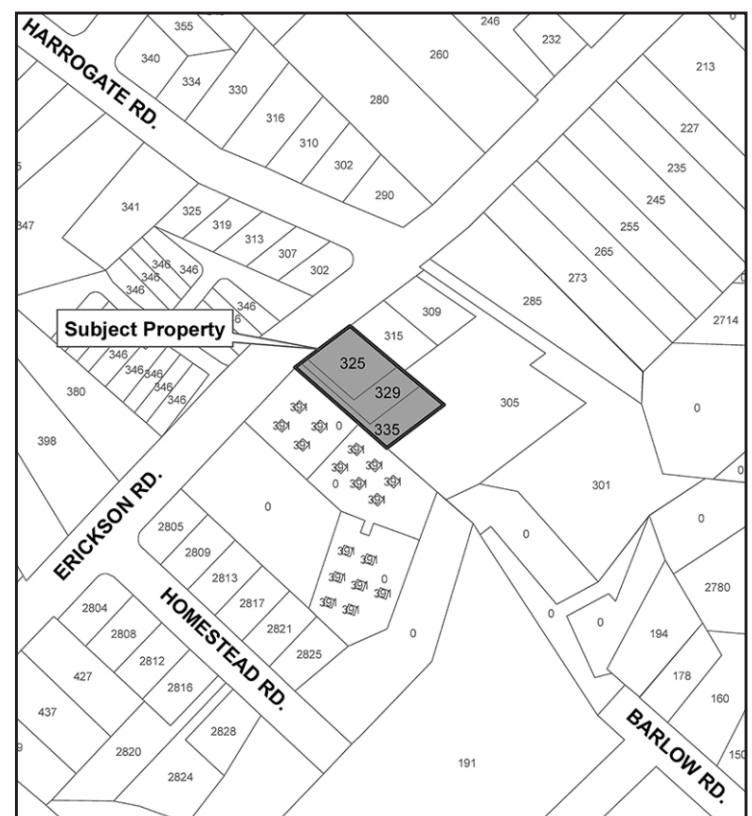
