#### PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE OPPORTUNITY FOR INPUT Zoning Bylaw Amendment

File: P20-46

A Public Hearing for a Rezoning Application at 1905 WOOD RD will be held at 6:30 p.m. on **November 16, 2020**. In order to minimize the spread of the COVID-19 virus, and pursuant to Ministerial Order M139, the City of Campbell River is hosting this meeting virtually.

What is the purpose of Zoning Amendment Bylaw 3789, 2020? The purpose of this application is to allow for the property at 1905 Wood Road to rezone from Residential Estate One (RE-1) to Residential Estate Two (R-2) to permit a duplex development.

#### **Legal Description**

LOT 18, DISTRICT LOT 53, SAYWARD DISTRICT, PLAN 10270 (civically known as 1905 WOOD RD).

#### How can I provide comments?

Speak at the Public Hearing via Zoom or share a written submission for Council's consideration. Submit written comments in advance to the attention of the Development Services Department by dropping them off to the drop box at the front entrance of City Hall, or by email to planning@campbellriver.ca, to be received no later than 4 p.m. on Tuesday, November 10, 2020.

The City of Campbell River will also be offering the ability to attend and participate in a Public Hearing via "Zoom" video conferencing. Participants may join the webinar using a smartphone, a tablet, or a computer with speakers and a microphone. For detailed instructions on how to participate via Zoom, please go to the City of Campbell River's Public Hearing Website to register at: campbellriver.ca/publichearing. The following is a basic overview of the process:

- Attendees will need to provide your first name, last name, email address, and city of residence.
- You do not need to have a Zoom account to participate in the Electronic Public Hearing. Once you register, you will receive an email with a link to join the Public Hearing as a participant.
- When you are in the webinar, you may use the raise hand function to indicate that you wish to speak.
- Using the raise hand function will automatically place you in a speakers' queue.
- When it is your turn to speak, the chairperson will call you by name, and you will be able to speak for up to five minutes.
- If you wish to speak again, you may use the raise hand function to be placed back into the speakers' queue.
