


LOCAL ELECTION: OCTOBER 15, 2022 VOTE BY MAIL

All eligible voters can vote by mail ballot in the City of Campbell River Local Election.

APPLY TO VOTE BY MAIL

Complete the online application form by Sept. 22, 2022, to have a voter package mailed to you.

From Sept. 22, 2022, until election day, you may still apply to pick up a voting package in person at City Hall, 301 St. Ann's Road, Campbell River, BC.



IMPORTANT DATES

The completed mail ballot package **must be received** at Campbell River City Hall no later than **4:30 p.m. on Friday, October 14, 2022**, or be hand delivered to the Presiding Election Official at the Campbell River Community Centre, 401 11th Avenue between **8 a.m. and 8 p.m. Saturday, October 15, 2022**. Any ballots received after this time will not be included in the count and marked as spoiled ballots.

PUBLIC HEARING previously scheduled for 6 p.m. September 7, 2022 **CANCELLED** due to missing location information in public notices.

DETAILS: The purpose of the proposed Zoning Bylaw Amendment is to allow for a future low- to medium-density residential subdivision, including single-family dwellings with suites and multi-family housing, totalling approximately 400 units. The proposed concept plan includes a public road, park space and environmental buffer areas.
