APPLY TO SERVE YOUR COMMUNITY ON THE BOARD OF VARIANCE

and play a role in development-related
decision-making in Campbell River

The Board of Variance is an independent, Council appointed panel that considers minor variances from the City's Zoning Bylaw (such as side yard setback). The Board will hear from an applicant and/or their neighbours, before considering whether the application is "minor" and whether "hardship" is evident, and either denying or approving an application. Appeals are generally made by homeowners or developers.

Apply to serve on the Board, in one of four spots available, for terms commencing on March 31, 2024, through March 31, 2027.

- No specific knowledge or qualifications are required, but an interest in civic governance and land use regulations is important.
- Members must be available to meet for approximately one hour, during working hours, when applications are received, typically 3 to 5 times a year. At least 10 days' notice will be given.
